

INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Warrill View Quarry, Silverdale QLD

(EPBC2020/8684)

Neilsen's Quality Gravels Pty Ltd is seeking approval under the *Environmental Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) for the establishment of a new quarry at 299 Hayes Road, Silverdale QLD 4307 (Lot 1 RP51909 & Lots 2, 7, 8, 10, 18 RP50377) (EPBC 2020/8684).

The proposed development was determined as a controlled action under the EPBC Act with assessment by Preliminary Documentation. The controlling provision is listed threatened species and communities (sections 18 & 18A of the EPBC Act), including the Koala (*Phascolarctos cinereus*) (combined populations of QLD, NSW and ACT) and the Grey-headed Flying-fox (*Pteropus poliocephalus*).

In accordance with section 95A(3) of the EPBC Act, public comments are now invited on Preliminary Documentation for the proposed development for a period of 10 business days from **3 July to 16 July 2026**. Hard copies of the Preliminary
